

Cases to Date in App District (Alleghany, Ashe, and Watauga counties)- (All data is current as of 6/24/2021 at 9 am)











Active Clusters and Outbreaks in Alleghany County

An outbreak is defined as two or more laboratory confirmed cases within a 14 day period in a congregate living setting. A cluster is defined as a minimum of five cases within a 14-day period and plausible epidemiologic linkage between cases. An outbreak or cluster is considered active until 28 days have passed with no newly identified cases. Additional information on the <u>definitions of outbreaks and clusters</u> is provided by the North Carolina Department of Health & Human Services.
