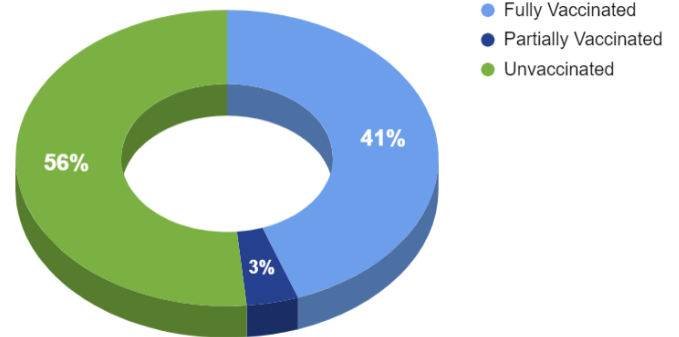
COVID-19 Vaccination Updates

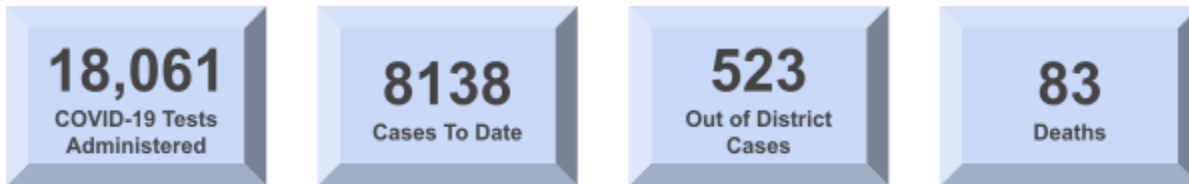

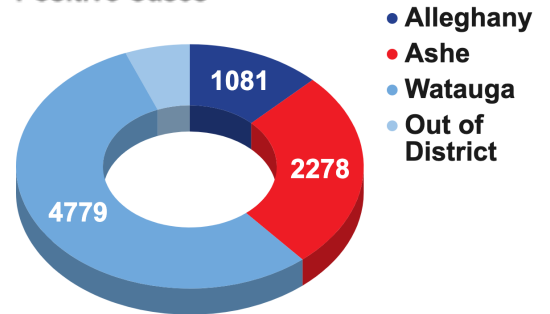
Cases to Date in App District (Alleghany, Ashe, and Watauga counties)- *(All data is current as of 7/8/2021 at 9 am)*



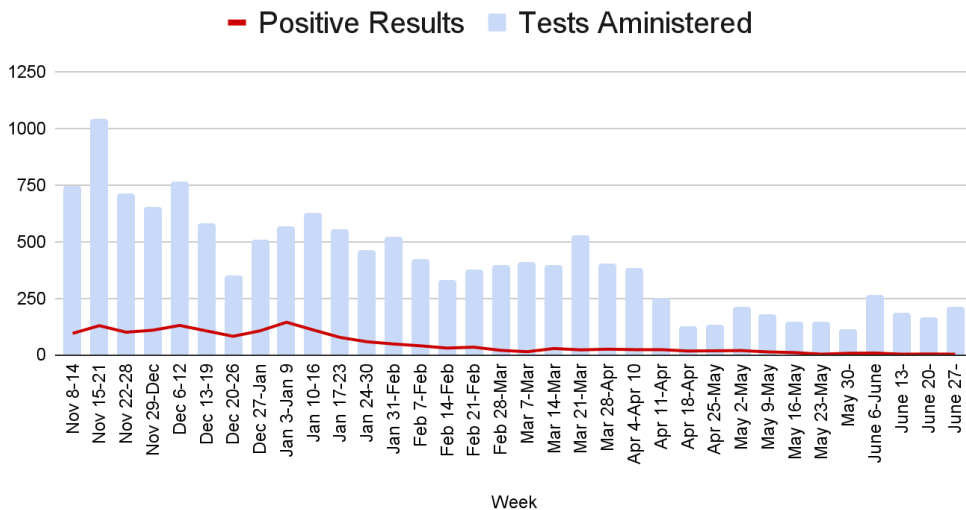
If you have COVID-19 symptoms or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 (regardless of whether or not you have symptoms), we recommend you be tested.

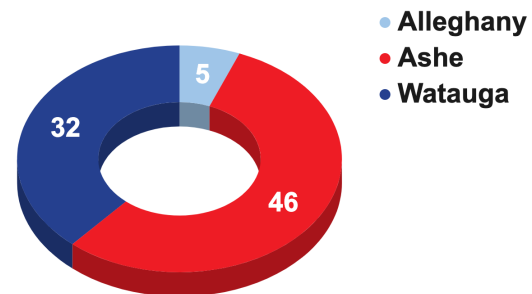
Positive Cases



Cumulative Testing by Week in Ashe



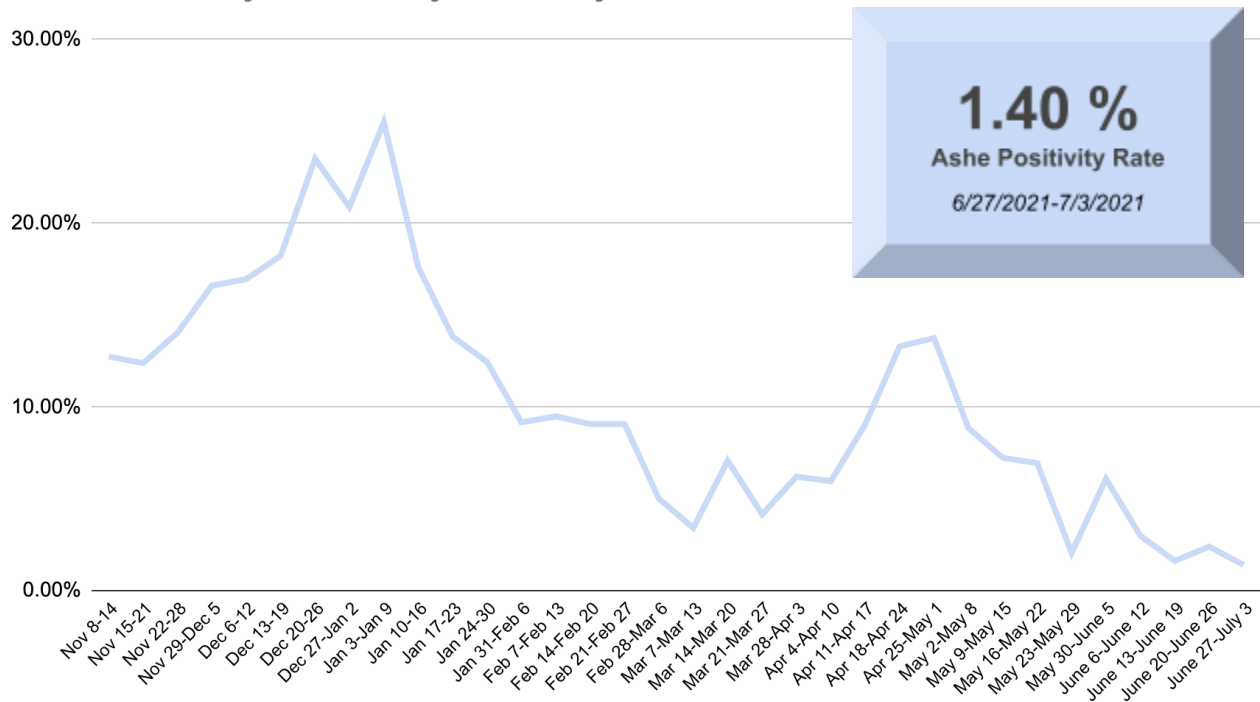
COVID-19 Deaths

Active Clusters and Outbreaks in Ashe County

An outbreak is defined as two or more laboratory confirmed cases within a 14 day period in a congregate living setting. A cluster is defined as a minimum of five cases within a 14-day period and plausible epidemiologic linkage between cases. An outbreak or cluster is considered active until 28 days have passed with no newly identified cases.
